The Re|Defining Adam Project focuses on teaching boys and men to challenge their understanding of gender norms and to recognize and interrupt sexism in casual conversation and other arena. One of the core objectives of this project to help boys and men both be and create safe spaces for the girls and women in their lives. Through parenting classes, workshops and events in traditional "male spaces", we help boys and men develop these new skills in environments familiar to them.

## CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION:

- Between the ages of 14-17 or 18-24
- Residents of Mississippi or Louisiana
- No diploma or degree requirements

## REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

- Attendance at monthly meetings
- Willingness to explore how their views and beliefs impact the lives and experiences of black girls and women
- No minimum GPA

## BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION:

- Opportunity to build social network(s) with peers and others
- Community service hours
- Field trips and community outings
- Leadership and advocacy skill-building, particularly around issues that affect black girls and women

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
